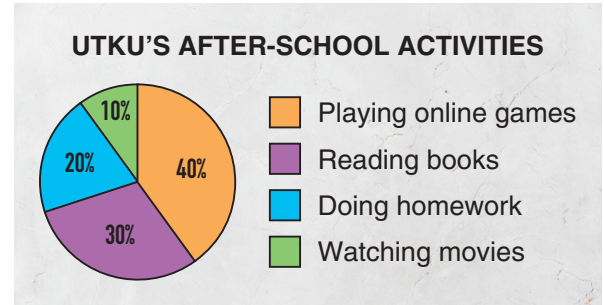

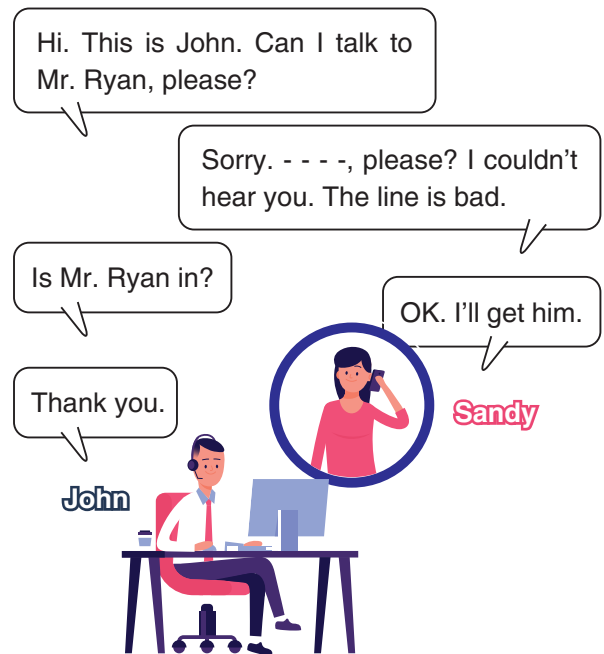
3. Utku is a secondary school student in Türkiye. The graphic below shows the percentages of his activities after school.
